


Med-Surg Specialists are to report the Final Diagnosis to the Chief Medical Officer before you receive the Patient Chart. If this step has not been completed, please advise the Case Manager.

Clinical Intervention Specialists Instructions:

- 1. Receive patient chart from Case Manager and review the patient's symptoms and final diagnosis.
- Examine your computer Patient Care Interface.
 Patient name should appear on your list of cases (lower left). Click on the name to see the Patient Chart (upper left).



3. Click on "Medi-Net" (lower right). Carefully select the course of treatment for the patient, AND a clinical trial if appropriate. Read through the various treatments and trials in the third column of Medi-Net and discuss them with your Case Manager and your team. Choose the most appropriate clinical trial and click "Select Treatment" or "Select Trial" at the bottom of the description.



4. Write your prescribed course of treatment on the Patient Chart. Write the information about any clinical trials on the Patient Chart, sign and date it, and pass it to your Case Manager. Note: If your Case Manager is really busy, update the Patient Status Board on the wall (if you are using one) before passing the Patient Chart to the Case Manager.
