ER Specialists – you work in the hospital Emergency Room is to examine patients, take vital signs, order tests, make an official diagnosis, treat patients recommend surgery if necessary, and admit or discharge from the hospital.

To continue patient care, complete the following:

- Click on patient waiting room and admit one or more patients to the Emergency Room; be sure to choose severe cases first based on the wristband color:
 - Red- Severe
 - Yellow – Moderate – Need further assessment to determine injury
 - Green – Minor wounds
- Proceed with patient assessment.
- Review Patient Scenario.
- Work down the patient chart by asking information such as name, age, are they hurt. Utilize the Patient Tracking Sheet to stay organized.
- Examine patient by clicking on body parts to determine extent of injury.
- Take vitals using the tools in Patient Chart.
- Click Open Medinet (medical resource guide) and try best to match symptoms to diagnose medical issues. Compare this to the Triage diagnosis and see if they are correct or if another diagnosis is necessary for the patient.
- You may have to order test for the patient to confirm diagnosis.
- **Confirm suspected diagnosis with Chief Medical Officer and once confirmed, click on Confirm again.**
- Proceed with treatment in order listed.
- After treatment determine if patient is to be discharged or if surgery is recommended, admit to hospital.
- You are the best hope for the patient's recovery!
